Show Jumping - Breydon Arena - 8.30 am

- Clear Round** Fences 40 - 45cm. Tickets will be limited and class will run for 30 mins only **Entry fee £3.00**
- Class One** **Mini Novice 50cm.** Any combination of horse/pony/rider not having won a class of over 60cm. Can be assisted or led. Table A7. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. This class will be split between adults and children if entries permit. **Entry fee £6.50**
- Class Two** **Open 60cm Speed Class.** One round against the clock. The winner will be the fastest round with the least faults. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £7.00**
- Class Three** **Pairs 65cm** Both riders to be in the arena with a baton swap between rounds. In the event of either of the combination having three refusals during the round the other rider must complete the course on their behalf, should this result in a further three refusals the pair will be eliminated. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £13 per pair**
- Class Four** **Open Topscore. Heights of fences to vary from 60cm – 90cm.** A fun class with jump heights for everyone! Each rider will have one minute to jump as many fences as possible, from either direction. Each fence will have points allocated to it, and can be jumped a maximum of three times each. Upon the sound of the bell the rider must have landed over any fence they are jumping for the points to be awarded. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £7.00**
- Class Five** **Open 85cm Speed Class.** One round against the clock. The winner will be the fastest round with the least faults. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £7.00**
- Class Six** **Open Take Your Own Line 95cm.** All fences to be jumped in any order chosen by the competitor, but must be jumped from the numbered side. Each competitor must start the clock after the bell has rung by passing through the start timing equipment. After completing all of the fences the competitor must pass through the finish timing equipment to stop the clock. The results will be decided on the fastest round with the least faults. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £7.00**
- Class Seven** **Redwings Grand Prix. Starting height, first round 1m.** Over three rounds all double clears to go to a third round jump off. In the event of less than six clears in the first or second round, the six competitors with the least faults in the fastest times from the round will go through to the next round carrying their faults through with them. The winner will be the rider with the least faults over the 3 rounds and the fastest time in the jump off. Special rosette for highest placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £9.00**

- Class Eight** **Best Condition Redwings Guardianship Scheme Equine.** Equine can be ridden on/off lead rein or shown as a companion on lead rein and not ridden. **Entry fee £3.50**
- Class Nine** **Best Condition Rescue Equine.** Equine can be ridden on/off lead rein or shown as a companion on lead rein and not ridden. Equine must be on a loan scheme from a registered charity. **Entry fee £3.50**
- Class Ten** **My Best Friend.** Open to any equine/child combination under 14.2hh and 16 years old. To be judged on manners, temperament and short ridden show which may include special activities that demonstrate how lovely your pony is! **Entry fee £3.50**
- Class Eleven** **Ridden Coloured:** Open to any piebald, skewbald, appaloosa, or paint horse. To be judged on type, conformation, movement and way of going. The judge will not ride. Each competitor will be asked to walk and trot, those on lead rein and novice/nervous riders will not be asked to canter. **Entry fee £5.00**
- Class Twelve** **Ridden Mountain and Moorland:** Open to equines that are a recognised English Native breed (excluding TB). To be judged on type, conformation, movement and way of going. The judge will not ride. Each competitor will be asked to walk and trot, those on lead rein and novice/nervous riders will not be asked to canter. **Entry fee 5.00**

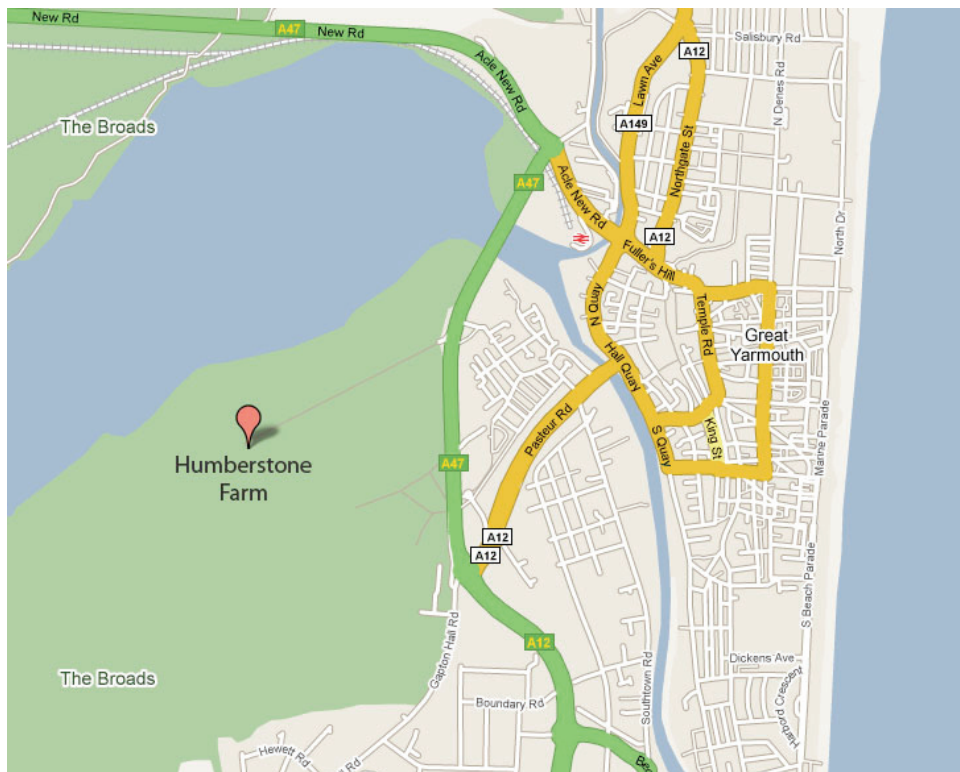
Class Thirteen Veteran Equine. Open to any equine over the age of 17. To be judged on condition, vitality and ridden show. Special rosette for oldest equine/rider combination! **Entry fee £5.00**

Class Fourteen Utility Equine. Open to any equine suitable for general hacking and light schooling. Will be judged on condition, temperament, ridden show and small jump. Ridden show must include walk, trot, canter and rider to dismount and re-mount (mounting block/leg up permitted). Class may be split horses/ponies should entries permit. Special rosette for best placed Guardianship Scheme equine. **Entry fee £5.00**

Rules and Conditions of Show

- The Judges' decision is final.
- The show jumping will be run under BSJA Rules 2009.
- Correct current BSI standard headgear must be worn to minimum approved standards at all times when mounted and chinstraps fastened.
- The Organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everybody must take care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and their Officials.
