Ring One Ridden Showing

9am

Indoor Arena

Rosettes 1st – 6th. First place from each class to go into the Ring One Championship.

- Class 1** Ridden Hunter. Combined Weight Class, open to all suitable horses over 15hh. To be judged on trueness to type, suitability, conformation, manners and way of going.
- Class 2** Ridden Hunter Pony. Combined Height Class, open to all suitable ponies 15hh and under. To be judged on trueness to type, suitability, conformation, manners and way of going.
- Class 3** Ridden Cob. Combined Weight Class, open to Traditional and Clipped cobs. To be judged on type, conformation and way of going.
- Class 4** Lead Rein Pony. Open to all ponies under 13hh, pony must be suitable for a child rider. To be judged on suitability for the child rider, manners and way of going.
- Class 5** First Ridden. Open to all ponies under 13hh suitable for riding off lead rein by a child rider. To be judged on way of going, manners and suitability.

Approximate time for short break

- Class 6** Ridden Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds. To be judged on trueness to type, conformation and way of going.
- Class 7** Ridden Mountain and Moorland Large Breeds. To be judged on trueness to type, conformation, movement and way of going.
- Class 8** Ridden Mountain and Moorland Part Breeds. To be judged on trueness to type, conformation, movement and way of going.
- Class 9** Ridden Coloured: Open to any piebald, skewbald, appaloosa, or paint horse. To be judged on conformation, movement and way of going.
- Class 10** **TARRA Ridden:** Open to all Thoroughbreds unraced and raced 4 years and over, who are registered with Weatherbys (passport will be checked). Racing name of horse to be used where appropriate. The first two placed will qualify for the TARRA Ridden Championships to be held in September 2010. If the first two have qualified then qualification will pass down the line to 4th place, only if there are 6 or more entries in the class. If fewer entries than 6, then qualification will pass to 1st and 2nd placed only. Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes allowed. Class to be judged on manners, way of going, ride/individual show and conformation. The Judge may ride. Judge's decision is final.
- Class 11** Riding Horse. Open to all suitable horses over 15hh. To be judged on type, suitability, conformation and way of going.
- Class 12** Ridden Arab and Part Breeds. To be judged on trueness to type, conformation and way of going.
- Class 13** Ridden Foreign Breeds. To be judged on trueness to type, conformation and way of going.

Ring One Championship, the Champion to go into the Supreme Championship - to be held in Ring One at the end of the show.

For all classes above, excluding class 10, the first, second and third placed horses/ponies will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2010. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. Best Condition Championship. Winners of classes 21,22,37 and 38 will compete for Best Condition Champion.

Supreme Championship. Champions from Ring One, Two, Three and Four and the winner of the Best Condition Championship will compete to be the Supreme Champion of the Show.

Ring Two In-hand Showing

Indoor Arena

Rosettes 1st – 6th . First place from each class to go into the Ring Two Championship.

- Class 14** Native Small Breeds
- Class 15** Native Large Breeds
- Class 16** Native Part Breeds
- Class 17** **TARRA In-hand:** Open to all Thoroughbreds unraced and raced, any age, who are registered with Weatherbys (passport will be checked). Racing name of horse to be used where appropriate. The first two will qualify for the TARRA In-hand Championships to be held in August 2010. If the first two have qualified then qualification will pass down the line to 4th place, only if there are 6 or more entries in the class. Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes allowed. Class to be judged on manners, suitability, way of going and conformation. Judge's decision is final.
- Class 18** Hunters. Mixed weights.
- Class 19** Cobs. Traditional and Clipped.
- Approximate time for short break*
- Class 20** Coloured horses/ponies.
- Class 21** Best Veteran. The winner of this class will qualify for the **Best Condition Championship**. Horse/Pony to be over 17 years of age.
- Class 22** Best Condition. The winner of this class will qualify for the **Best Condition Championship**. The judge will be looking for the ideal weight and physical condition of the equine.
- Class 23** Best Rescue. Entries to this class must be on loan from a registered charity.
- Class 24** Best Companion Pony. Entries to this class must be an un-ridden horse/pony that is companion to another.
- Class 25** Young Handler. This class is open to any child under 16. The judge will be looking for the handler's ability and knowledge of the pony they are showing and their ability to show it to its best potential.

For all classes above excluding class 24, the first, second and third placed horses/ponies will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2010. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. Ring Two Championship, the Champion to go to the Supreme Championship - to be held in Ring One at the end of the show.

Ring Three Utility and Working Hunter; Fun Show Jumping

Outdoor Arena

Rosettes 1st – 6th . First place in each class to go into the Ring Three Championship.

- Class 26** Utility Pony under 13.2hh. Lead Rein Permitted. To be judged on manners, temperament and suitability for general riding. Riders to show walk, trot, canter if happy to and a small jump (optional). Horse/pony must be ridden in a snaffle bridle.
- Class 27** Utility Pony 13.2hh – 14.3hh. To be judged on manners, temperament and suitability for general riding. Riders to show walk, trot, canter if happy to and a small jump (optional). Horse/pony must be ridden in a snaffle bridle.
- Class 28** Utility Horse Over 14.2hh. Rules as above.
- Approximate time for short break*
- Class 29** Working Pony 13hh and under. To be judged on type, conformation, way of going, jumping round, manners and suitability. Course not to exceed 2'

Ring Three Continued

- Class 30** Working Pony Over 13hh – 15hh. To be judged on type, conformation, way of going, jumping round, manners and suitability. Course height 2'3" – 2'6"
- Class 31** Novice Working Hunter Over 15hh. Horse may not have been placed 1st or 2nd in any working hunter competition. Course height 2'3" – 2'6"
- Class 32** Open Working Hunter Over 15hh. Course height 2'6" – 2'9"
- Ring Three Championship**, the Champion to go to the Supreme Championship to be held in Ring One at the end of the show.
- Class 33** 40 cm Fun Show jumping, clear round to be followed by jump off
- Class 34** 50 cm Fun Show jumping, clear round to be followed by jump off
- Class 35** 60 cm Fun Show jumping, clear round to be followed by jump off

Ring Four Turnout, Condition and Fun Showing

Indoor Arena

Rosettes 1st – 4th first place from each class to go into the Ring Four Championship.

- Class 36** Ridden Best Turned Out. Open to all. To be judged on presentation and cleanliness of horse and rider.
- Class 37** Ridden Best Condition Horse/Pony. This winner of this class will qualify for the **Best Condition Championship**. The judge will be looking for the ideal weight and physical condition of the equine.
- Class 38** Ridden Best Veteran. This winner of this class will qualify for the **Best Condition Championship**. The judge will be looking for the ideal weight and physical condition of the equine and a ridden show.
- Class 39** Ridden Best Rescue. Entries into this class must be on loan from a registered charity. To be judged on condition and show.
- Class 40** My Best Friend. Open to any equine/child combination under 14.2hh and 16 years old. To be judged on manners, temperament and short ridden show, which may include special activities that demonstrate how lovely your pony is!

- Class 41** Thelwell Pony. To be judged on similarity to Penelope and Kipper, may be led.
- Class 42** Longest Mane. Need we say more!
- Class 43** Longest and Best Condition Feather
- Class 44** Prettiest Mare
- Class 45** Handsomest Gelding

Ring Four Championship, the Champion to go to the Supreme Championship to be held in Ring One at the end of the show.

Ring Five Handy Pony

- Class 46** Handy Pony. Tickets to be sold on the gate. Try your hand and hoof around the obstacle course! The winner is the combination that completes the course in the fastest time. £2 per round.

Additional Information and Entry Form

Entries Close 4th May 2010. All classes can be entered on the day with a £1 levy per class, provided classes are not full.

The Easton College canteen will be open throughout the day, serving a large range of snacks through to full main meals.

Eastern Lights Photography will be attending the show. Memories of the day will be available to purchase at the show.

The Redwings Horse Sanctuary display lorry will be in attendance providing information on the welfare work that is at the heart of the charity.

Rules and Conditions of Show

- The Judge's decision is final.
- Any complaints or appeals must be lodged with the secretary no more than 30 mins after the incident. The complaint must be lodged with the accompaniment of £20, if the complaint is upheld the money will be refunded. It is expected all competitors will enter into the spirit of the event for fun and recognition of the welfare of the horse.
- Correct current BSI standard headgear must be worn to minimum approved standards at all times when mounted and chinstraps fastened.
- The Organisers of the event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everybody must take care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and their Officials.
- Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers of the event, neither Redwings Horse Sanctuary, the owners of the venue, or any other agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders spectators, vehicles and their contents or accessories, or any other person or property at all, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way, whatsoever.
- Entries made on the day will be £1 extra per class, with the exception of the handy pony. No refunds available on classes entered.
- Please consider the welfare of the equines. Any person using excessive use of whip or spurs will be asked to retire from the show.
