Make your own or seshoe photo frame

You will need:

- □ Cardboard (cereal box would be ideal)
- □ Pencil
- □ Scissors (with an adult's help)
- □ Template
- O Glue
- □ Picture
- □ Decorative materials





"You can use paint, pens, stickers, buttons, ribbon...the possibilities are endless! Have fun decorating!"



Draw two horseshoe shapes, of the same size, onto your card. You can do this freehand or use the template provided on the Young Redwings website www.youngredwings.co.uk/ uploads/images/1133.pdf. Cut these out, but only cut the centre out of one. These will make the front and back of your frame.



Cut a small piece off the base of your horseshoe shapes to make them level, so your frame can stand up.



Use the template to draw and cut out the stand for your frame. Fold along the score line and put to one side.



Trim your photo to size and stick to the backing card (horseshoe with centre not cut out).



Now decorate the other horseshoe shape how you like. This is the front of your frame. Here we have used ribbon to wrap ground our frame but Fred the cat has a few more suggestions for you.



Glue the decorated horseshoe to the backing card, making sure the picture shows through. Then glue the stand to the backing card. If need be, bend the stand to help it stand up.
