

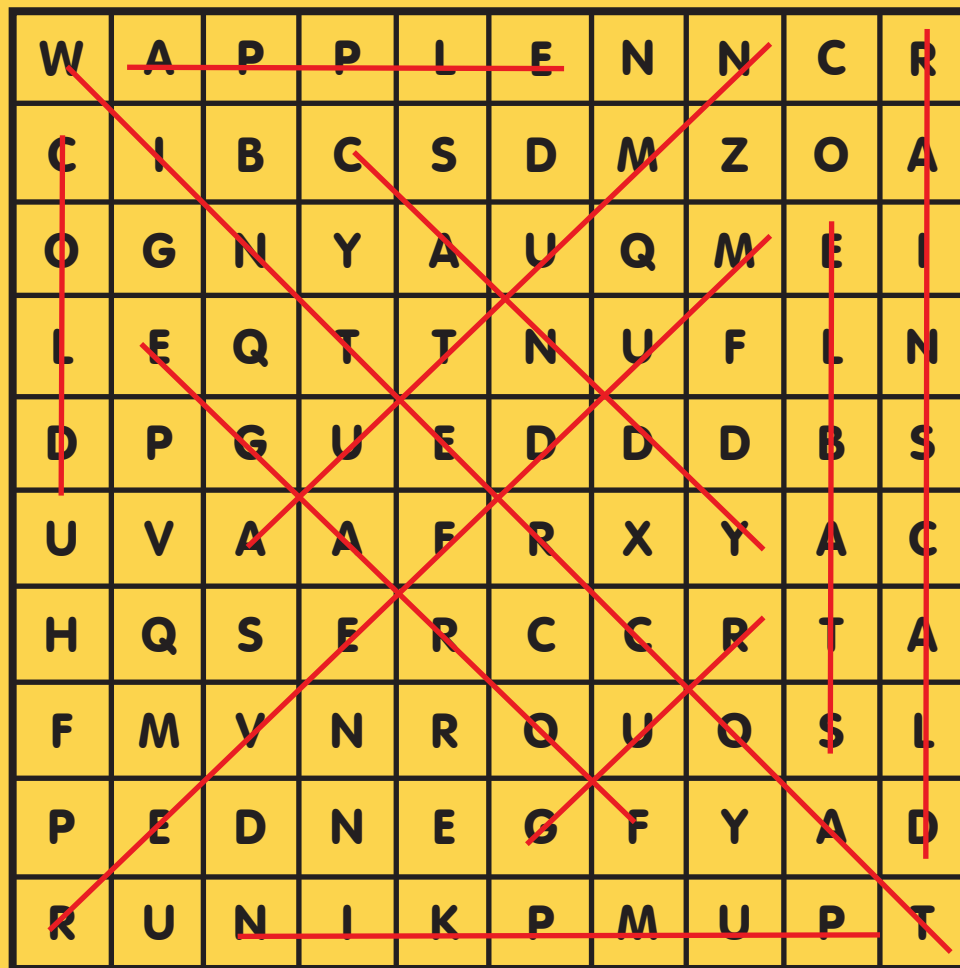
Wicked Wordsearch!
