

Make a carrot cake for your horse!

How to make a carrot cake for your horse!

1. Soak some basic high-fibre pony nuts in water (just enough to cover) and leave to stand for a few hours. We use Spillers High Fibre cubes. Once they've expanded nicely and can be moulded, you are ready to assemble your cake!
2. Mould the soaked pony nuts into whatever shape you like.
3. Then decorate with a selection of the following: carrots, apples, horse mix, mint powder, peppermints and ginger biscuits – the latter are a particular favourite of donkeys!
