## START

Spin an even number to call the vets to start the game

You are given medicine in the field to reduce the pain and swelling. This makes you feel a bit better. Move forward 1 space.

Wow that was quick! The horse ambulance is here, off you go! Take the short cut.

At the Horse Hospital, you need an X-ray. Miss a go to wait for the results.

Oh dear! You have a fractured splint bone. You have to be on box rest for 4-6 weeks. Miss a go.

You must be feeling better, you do not need to take any more medication. Take the short cut.

The vet is happy with your progress. You no longer need bandages and your medication has been reduced. Move forward 1 space.

Oh look! A toy has been added to your stable, which is fun to play with and keeps you relaxed and entertained. Take the short cut.

The vet is worried about your progress so would like another X-ray. Go all the way back.

Your leg is dressed and you are given your medicine. You've been a great patient, take the short cut!

After 5 weeks rest, the vets are happy for you to be moved to a woodchip paddock. Stretch your legs and move forward 1 space.

Your best friend has been brought over to keep you company, what a lovely surprise. Miss a go while you catch up.

At 6 weeks the vets are happy for you to return to your herd. You're so excited! Move forward 4 spaces!

It's been a while since you've seen your other friends, so you take some time to settle back in. Miss a go while you regain your confidence.

## FINISH

Hooray! You are back to full health and back with your herd.
