Steps to make an origami finger game



1 Fold the sheet of paper twice diagonally and open it again.



2 Pattern side down, fold each corner to the centre of the sheet of paper.



3 Turn over the square and redo step 2, folding each corner to the centre.



4 Fold the square horizontally each way.



5 Slip your fingers into the bottom corner of each square and push into shape.



6 Now you can open and close it horizontally and vertically with your fingers.
