Poorly Piper is lame and is receiving vet treatment, but needs to be with a friend.

Poor little Ava is recovering from an operation and needs lots of vet care.



Meg

Meg is a big Shire who needs to live in a grass paddock. She was on Paddock 1 but her hooves have churned up the grass so it needs to be rested for a while and no horses or donkeys can live on it.
